## **Administrative Record File Availability for a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study for Disposal of Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant CERCLA Wastes**

An Administrative Record File is open and available for public inspection for a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study to evaluate options for the disposal of Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) wastes, including an on-site disposal option (sometimes referred to as a CERCLA cell) and off-site disposal options.

DOE seeks to inform the public of the availability of the record file and encourages the public to comment on documents as they are placed in the record file. Comments should be sent to Jeff Snook, U.S. Department of Energy, Box 1410, Paducah, KY 42002.

The Administrative Record is the collection of documents that form the basis for making a decision on how to solve a specific environmental problem.
